What Drawing a Clock Reveals About Your Brain Health

You've drawn a clock face before. But could you do it right now, from memory, with the hands set to 10 after 11? Neurologists have used this deceptively simple test for decades to screen for early cognitive changes, because getting it right requires memory, spatial reasoning, and executive function to work together simultaneously. The errors people make, and where they make them, tell a specific story about how the brain is functioning.

What's more interesting is what comes after the test. New research suggests that drawing itself may actually build the cognitive skills it measures, activating regions of the brain tied to memory, attention, and even a meditative-like state of flow.
